SERVING UP HISTORY ON A PLATE

A cattle stampede on a dinner plate? Pioneers fording a stream? Imagine the history of the West, then read about it in *Come and Get It: The Saga of Western Dinnerware* by Corinne Joy Brown and published by **Big Earth Publishing**.

Colorado author Brown is no stranger to the history of the West: Besides being a frequent contributor to *Western & English Today*, she's been a staff writer for Persimmon Hill since 1988 and is a senior writer for *Working Ranch Magazine*. She's also penned two popular novels, both set in the West.

Brown first fell in love with Western dinnerware when she delved into it for a 2007 assignment for *Western & English Today*. "If there was one vintage pattern," she thought, thoroughly seduced by its illustrated charm, there must have been others."

And so began a journey of more than 400 plates: a personal collection she amassed during the following two years. But collection wasn't enough: Brown needed to know who made them, for what purpose, and when. The search resulted in this 240-page, lavishly illustrated and engagingly written tome.
